

Exercise 1: Foreground and Background Images

All work in this exercise needs to happen on your USB flashdrive.

1. You are going to use foreground and background images to re-create part of the Apple homepage as it appeared in September 2013.
2. In a browser, go to this URL: https://www.sugarsync.com/pf/D242105_6103826_8486417.
3. Download and unzip the file. You'll find five images: *apple.jpg*, *ios_title_small.png*, *watch_keynote_small.png*, *learn_more_small.jpg* and a reference image called *Screen Shot 2013-09-02 at 17.35.03.png*. Place these images in the images folder.
4. In TextWrangler, open *boilerplate.html* and save it as *pages/apple.html*.
5. In the body, create a division to hold the background image: `<div style="background-image:url(../images/apple.jpg);width:1024px;height:600px;">`
6. Use the `
` element to force a new line, then add the *ios_title_small.png* image.
7. Add *watch_keynote_small.jpg*, a `
`, and then *learn_more_small.jpg*.
8. Close the division element with a `</div>` and save your code.
9. View it in your browser and compare it to the reference image.
10. Try to copy the background image by dragging it to the desktop. Try the same with the other images. What happened, and why?
11. Why would you want to design a page in this way?
